Male, Age 3, Leukemia
This young man has had a very difficult road. He is in need of a BMT but several rounds of chemo have still not been successful in getting the leukemia under control.

Female, Age 6, Leukemia
This sweet girl has been
traveling a rough road. She has
a younger brother. Family can
use gift cards.

Female, Age 15, Rhabdomyosarcoma

Patient lives with grandma. Family has had a difficult time since diagnosis emotionally, physically, mentally and financially.

Female, Age 8, Leukemia Father is sole provider. Car broke down. Only vehicle for work & doctors appointment. Need assistance with car repair bill.

Female, Age 6, Leukemia Has been battling leukemia for two years. 4 siblings. Long road still ahead.

treatment and a BMT, she has
relapsed with AML. She was
given her diagnosis on
Christmas Day. Both parents
are field workers.

Female, Age 19, Sickle Cell This young woman was diagnosed with SCD at birth.
